SUN FAS

HULL: Infusion GRP sandwich with balsa coring. Infused structural inner liner glued into place. DECK: Infusion GRP sandwich with foam coring.

BULKHEADS: Infusion GRP sandwich moulded companionway, mast and forward bulkheads.
